Just Trade import many beautiful ranges of jewellery and other accessories from Peru. Among their most popular items are the beautifully contemporary Semilla bracelets, made from seeds from the Peruvian jungle threaded onto memory wire. They wrap around the wrist about three times. Necklaces and earrings are also available to match some of the styles.

Some bracelets, such as the one pictured above, are in their natural colour, whilst others are dyed to stunning effect. Availability fluctuates, as does the colouring of the naturally coloured bracelets. Don't worry—if we supply one which isn't what you expected, we will take it back, of course.

Natural Seed Bracelets



Huayruro Seeds

The most commonly used type of Huayruro is small and bright red with a black dot, known as 'male'. Perhaps due to the unusual natural colouring there is a long held belief among Peruvians that these seeds have the dual power to attract good fortune and ward off evil spirits. The belief that they bring good luck means that they are often used in jewellery or tied to babies' wrists with a red ribbon ensuring the wearer benefits from these qualities. There are many different varieties of Huayruro and the Zoe project uses the less traditionally recognised reddish orange Huayruro known as 'female' and the dark red thought to be a hybrid between the male and female Huayruros. They grow deep in the jungle areas, on tall trees in a pod similar to a pea. The dark red (or red & black) variety is usually discarded as not perceived to be a 'proper' Huayruro, so might not keep away bad luck! Seen as a freak of nature, they are known as 'accidente'.

Choloque Seeds

The round black Choloque seeds are around 12-15 mm in diameter and come from the Amazonian Soapberry Plant (*Sapindus Saponaria*). The fruit looks like a grape, but the flesh of the fruit when mashed acts as a natural detergent and is still used by villagers in the rainforest to wash clothes.

The Zoe project is co-ordinated by Just Trade who help small fair trade projects to grow, giving advice and providing a long term route to market.

These elegant short necklaces in white, pink, turquoise, green and grey are made with nylon-coated metal, glass and pearl effect beads.

They are hand made by the Zoe fair trade project in Lima, Peru , like the beautiful seed jewellery that **esme** also stocks.

The necklace is supplied with a tag attached that explains about the work of the project, in an elegant organza bag with ribbon drawstring.

The design appeals to people of all ages and make a wonderful gift, as well as a perfect introduction to fair trade.
